



**Undertaking given by IQL UK Limited to Qualifications Wales in accordance with Condition B8 of the Standard Conditions of Recognition, March 2017 (“the Conditions”).**

IQL UK Limited will take specific actions in respect of the following qualifications (“the qualifications”):

- Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work;
- Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work;
- Level 3 Award in Emergency Paediatric First Aid; and
- Level 3 Award in Paediatric First Aid

With a view to securing compliance with the Conditions, before **4pm on 1 February 2018**, IQL UK Limited will:

1. Submit to Qualifications Wales revised sample assessment materials that:
  - a. effectively assess all learning outcomes and assessment criteria in full, in accordance with currently accepted first aid practice.
  - b. include a written document which sets out clear criteria against which learners’ level of attainment can be differentiated, for both knowledge and practical assessments.
2. Update the qualification materials to clarify the conditions for completion of assessment and how the Awarding Body will ensure the evidence generated reflects learners’ own work.
3. Set out an action plan for issuing revised materials to tutors and assessors, once approved by Qualifications Wales, to ensure that the criteria against which learners’ performance will be differentiated are understood and applied accurately and consistently, by assessors.
4. a. Update processes and guidance for internal quality assurance of the qualifications, to ensure this meets all aspects of the Skills for Health assessment principles, and to allow assessment decisions to be reviewed and revised where necessary.
