Special Condition of Recognition

We wrote to you on 26 March 2020 confirming that we had issued a special condition of recognition on WJEC-CBAC in relation to its Moderation processes and procedures for Approved GCSEs, AS, A-level and Welsh Baccaulaureate Skills Challenge Certificate qualifications, as intended to work for the 2020 summer examination series. This special condition of recognition took effect immediately and is applied to WJEC-CBAC until 31 August 2020.
