## 2023 Statement of Compliance Launched

Today we are launching the Statement of Compliance (SoC) for 2023.

Please remember that the submission window runs from Monday 16 October 2023 – Friday 19 January 2024, and you will be required to submit your response via the SoC area of the Portal. This can be found on the left of your screen when you log into the Portal.

Once you have submitted your SoC, colleagues at the Regulator(s) you are recognised with will review your response. Our review will include sampling responses to check that the name given for your Governing Body Chair tallies with other records, to ensure that it meets our requirements.
