Annual Statement to your regulator

Dear Responsible Officer,

We are confirming our high-level approach to the annual statement of compliance for 2023.

Condition B2 of the General Conditions of Recognition (Ofqual and CCEA Regulation) and the Standard Conditions of Recognition (Qualifications Wales) requires you, and the Chair of your Governing Body, to jointly submit an [annual statement](#) specifying whether or not your organisation is fully compliant with your Conditions of Recognition.

The window for the annual statement will open on Monday 16 October 2023 and close on Friday 19 January 2024.

We are continuing the 3-country approach this year with Qualifications Wales and CCEA Regulation so any data submitted will be shared with the regulator you are regulated by.

This means you will need to complete one statement in a standard format agreed by the 3 regulators. We will be using the Portal to collect your responses, and to send all correspondence, as we did last year. Please make sure that your Portal notifications are switched on so that you will remain up to date on all communications.

As well as asking you to consider your compliance against all relevant conditions this year we will also include some specific questions around key areas which are still to be confirmed but we will share further detail in advance of release.


